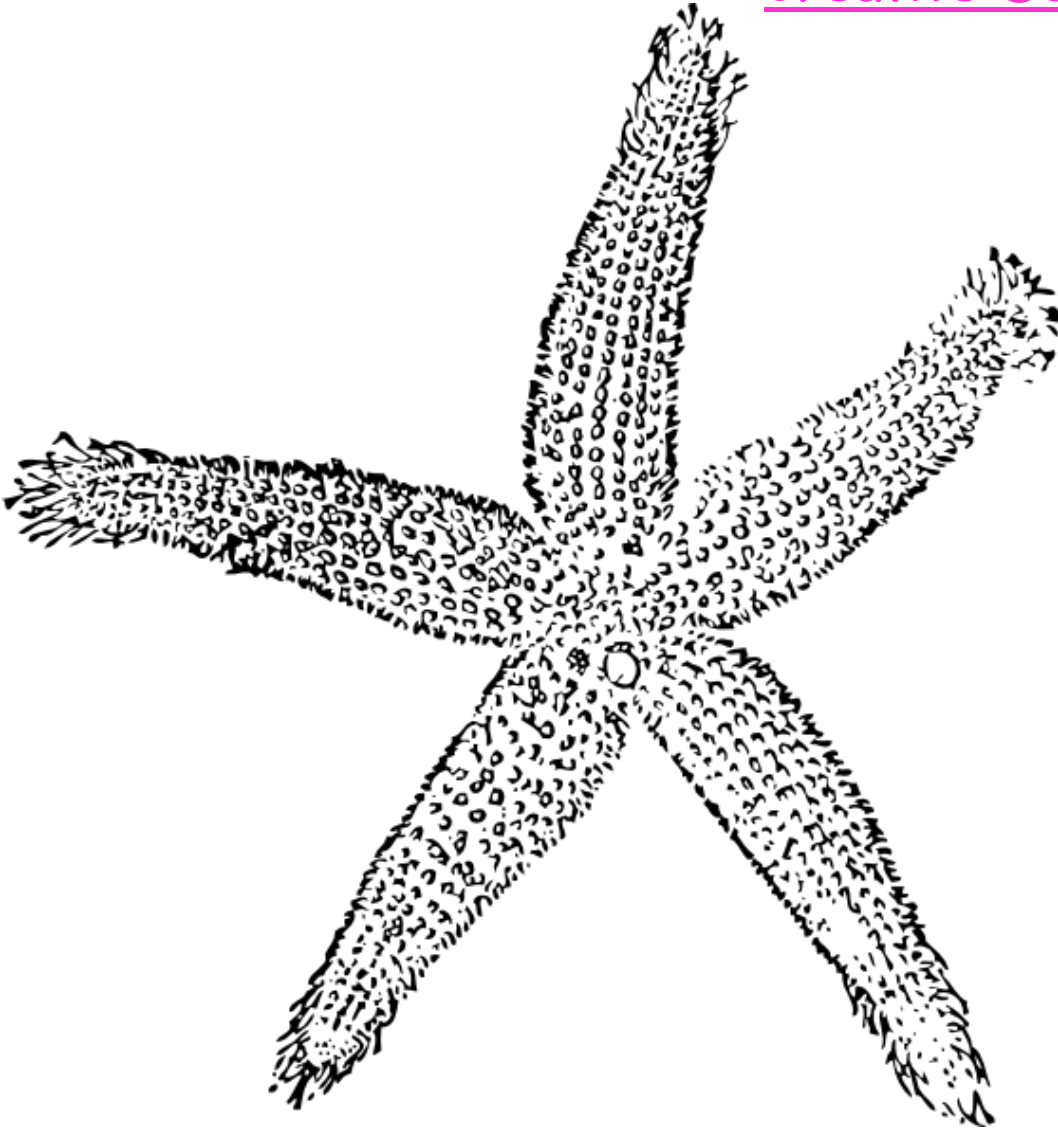


Creative Development
